Total Credits

Requirements: 30 credits all together

- 24 credits-course work
- 6 credit Project (MINE 597)

24 credits

- Up to 6 credits may be numbered 300 or 400 level; the remaining must be 500 level numbers.
- 50% should be mining courses (MINE)
- You may find other suitable courses offered by EOSC, GEOE, CIVL, MECH, CHBE.



Satisfactory Grades

- Passing grade for graduate students is 60% in all courses whether undergraduate or graduate level courses.
- A maximum of 6 credits can have grades between 60 and 67%. More than that and they do not count towards the total credits.
- If you get less than 60% on a course, you must retake the course and achieve at least 74%.



Registration Periods

- You have 2 weeks at the start of the course to try it out. You can drop with no penalty by the add drop deadline.
- Withdraw "W" status if you withdraw after the first two weeks until the withdraw deadline.
- After the withdraw deadline there is no option for dropping the course.



Audit Course

- Course appears on transcript with "Audit" standing. You will not receive a grade for the course.
- You are not expected to write the final exam for an Audit course but are expected to do all other course activities (labs, midterms, quizzes, projects, papers, etc.).
- You can fail a course you are auditing.
- Some instructors may be more flexible. Confirm any agreements by email so you have a record.
- Requires a Change of Registration Form.



Academic Terms

- The academic year at UBC is divided into 3 terms:
 - 2025W T1 (register June 3)
 - 2025W T2 (register June 3)
 - 2026S (register in March/ April 2026)

Registration

- Now you can register for T1 and T2
- You can make changes with no penalty up until the second week of classes.
- You have a chance to register for up to 5 courses per term and then drop some when you have decided.

What to Register

- MINE 501A is the summer orientation course, even though it appears as a winter session course. The work for this course will be completed during August and early September.

- 2 credits

- All grad students are expected to attend the weekly/ monthly seminar <u>but don't register in the SSC unless you plan to present.</u>
- Wait until the term when you know you will present and then register.
